2. Purpose

This report seeks the endorsement of the Cabinet Member for Culture, Leisure and Sport for the Literature Development Strategy. It makes recommendations that will provide a framework for literature in the city over the next four years.

3. Information requested

3.1 Background

While the city's literary heritage has always played an important part in Portsmouth's cultural profile, there has never been a specific Literature Development Strategy to support and guide any work undertaken. With the appointment of a Literature Development Officer in 2010 it was agreed that a strategy be produced that provided a framework for literature in the city over the five year period of 2011-2016. The success of the Dickens 2012 campaign has shown the potential for a strong literature focus as part of Portsmouth's cultural strategy.

3.2 Consultation

A number of internal and external partners were consulted during the preparation of the Literature Development Strategy and subsequent to the previous report in September 2011. These include but are not limited to those listed in Appendix B.
