I have viewed the CCTV footage - there are 2 cameras but unfortunately neither covers the incident where the doorman is assaulted.

The first (camera 1) shows the suspect outside with a female and he goes inside at 02:51 hours. It then does not show anything until a number of doorstaff are seen to go towards the front door and then a male is the restrained on the floor outside the pub.

The second (camera 7) shows the suspect come into the club, he knocks into someone and is then approached by the bar manager. He swings his arm towards the bar manager at which point a member of door staff comes over, talks to the male and they both then walk to the front door together. They go out of sight into the foyer area between the two sets of front doors and cannot be seen again.

[REDACTED] has been interviewed 13:30 to 13:51 hours and denies any assault. He states that he was drunk but not drunk and disorderly. He cannot remember much of what happened stating that he remembers being outside for a cigarette and then going back inside. He states that he was wearing cream jeans, a black t shirt with a white trainer on the front and white trainers. He states that the person he bumped into was someone he knows as [REDACTED] who comes into the barber shop where he works and has known him for about 6 months since he came out of prison but he does not know his surname. He does know his phone number.

He states that it is not like him to fight and he has only been done for fighting once before. He does not remember pushing or hitting anyone, does not remember being asked to leave. He states he did not punch anyone he only defends himself.

I have just obtained a statement from the bar manager, [REDACTED] but have so

far been unable to contact [REDACTED] who's phone is not currently connecting. From RMS he lives in Gosport at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] has confirmed that he was pushed by [REDACTED] and so a further arrest for battery on him is required.

Attended Guildhall Walk after reports that drunk IC3 males were squaring up to each other after leaving The Roast Bar. The males involved were repeatedly told to leave the area by colleagues prior to my arrival. The suspect eventually got into a taxi but then decided to get out of the taxi and continued to try squaring up to people. He was again told to leave the area. At this point he became extremely verbally abusive to police officers he was then arrested for D&D. The male was heavily intoxicated with possible drug use.

This statement is in relation to Police attendance at Roast Bar, Guildhall Walk at approximately 02:40hrs on the above date. Doorstaff called Police after some IC3 males were involved in an argument inside the bar. The group were removed from the bar by staff but continued to argue whilst outside.

On our arrival most of the group had dispersed and got into taxis. However, there was one IC3 male who was staggering around and appeared to be heavily under the influence of alcohol. He was joined by another male and they began to argue. The decision was made to leave the scene but monitor from a short distance as our presence seemed to be encouraging the two. Once we had moved away, the two males then got into a taxi and left the area.

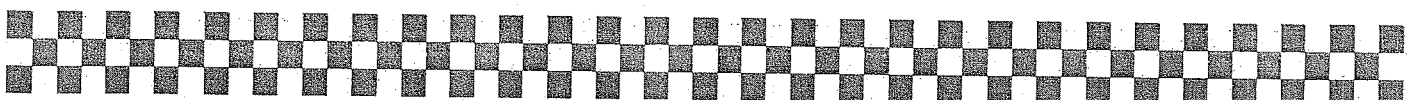

At 0210 hours PS Juster and myself observed an unruly crowd gathering around the entrance to Roast Bar- This was difficult at first to differentiate from the smoking area. We understood the premises was closed to the general public from 0200 but it was apparent that people were being allowed in. When it was challenged the excuse of a guest list was given stating that members of the public were permitted in until 0230 hours paying £15.00 including a meal?? This was again challenged as the guest list was anybody and the venue queue was dispersed by the head doorman and the premises suddenly closed to new customers. This soon appeared to be operating again and when I inspected the list it was handwritten and appeared that id details were being copied onto the list. I evidence this by the fact that I checked the last person against the list to show id and it was handwritten at the bottom of the list- more than pure coincidence I feel. A large oriental male was obstructive (Wendy you know him) stating this was the norm. I felt it was clearly an attempt to breach a loop hole and I informed him it would be fed back to you guys. Due to the location it also caused a large gathering to collect outside of the premises due to the loud music emitting into the street and I know without a visible presence more people would be permitted in.

This place was a complete mess tonight was very poor management. The queue was disorganised and not monitored by staff which led to arguments and scuffles when people were thought to be pushing in. The bar stopped allowing people to enter the premises at around 2.15 but no one had thought to start telling customers that had been queuing for 15 minutes or more that they would not get in. A number of people walked through the smoking barrier and avoided the queue altogether. The smoking are was not monitored and this was easy to do. Those who were caught were ejected but complained about being ejected. A crowd of people were standing outside the front of the venue; all seem to be saying they were on the guest list. There seems no apparent limit to the guess list and a number of staff members have different guests. A number of scuffles were calmed by police who had to stand and police the venue to quell the potential for violence. At one point I discussed a section 161 with A/Insp Jim and the decision to continue to monitor was made.

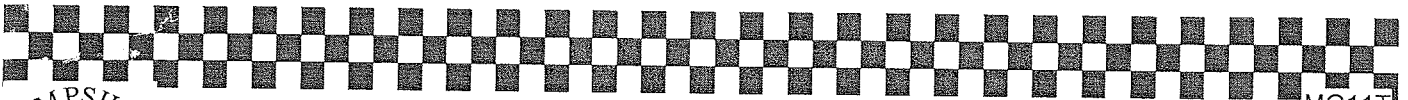

I am PC 23767 ADLEM of Hampshire Constabulary currently stationed at Southsea Police Station. On Thursday 11th of September 2010 I was on duty with PC 24400 BABER crewed in Police vehicle PS52.

At approximately 03.30 hours we attended the Guildhall Walk, Portsmouth after a report of a fight. On Police arrival there were a large number of persons in the immediate vicinity of the White Swan Public House all stood around in the road. There was no fighting taking place on Police arrival. On exiting the Police vehicle it became apparent after trying to speak with the members of the public that everyone was very reluctant to speak with the Police. We struggled to establish the details as to what had gone on. Despite many Door Staff being in the vicinity on Police arrival, by the time we had exited the Police Vehicle most Door Staff had dispersed resulting in us not knowing who had been involved or allowing us to establish what had gone on. PC 24400 BABER dealt with a young female and a male whilst I tried to establish from others present what had gone on. Without the co-operation of those left hanging around in the area and Door Staff seeming as though they had no understanding as to what had gone on either, we decided to remain in the area to provide a visible Police presence until all parties dispersed and there was no further issues brought to our attention.

It was not until some time later that I was advised by PC 23765 HALL from the Licensing Department at Southsea Police Station about a violent disorder which had actually taken place within the Guildhall Walk that night prior to our arrival.

I informed her that this was the description of the offender and she stated that another police officer had spoken to her and given her these details. I asked who she called and she stated that it was 0845 so was probably police staff. I also spoke to her in relation to the ROAST BAR footage and have informed her that at this time I have not been able to view an assault or the agg'd or the offender. She was not very happy with this and I have stated that I need to speak to [REDACTED] in relation to the exact location of the assault. This statement is reference my dealings with a male I now know to be [REDACTED]. During this statement I will refer to him as [REDACTED].

On Sunday 2nd May 2010 I was duty in full uniform. I was a VCS duty in the Guildhall, PORTSMOUTH. I was in company with PC22856 MERRYWEATHER.

At 0135hrs on the same date I was stood outside the Roast Bar when I was made aware of a fight outside the entrance to Grosvenor Casino. As I approached I saw door staff struggling with a male who was extremely aggressive. I now know this male to be [REDACTED] PC22856 MERRYWEATHER and I went over to deal with the incident. We were joined by other officers. [REDACTED] was arrested by PC22856 MERRYWEATHER on suspicion of assault on a member of the door staff. The member of staff who was assaulted was [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was heavily intoxicated. He was very unsteady on his feet. He had been ejected from the casino and during this process had become aggressive towards door staff. I would state that by the way [REDACTED] was acting, the way he was very unsteady on his feet and the fact that his speech was very slurred very heavily in drink. On a scale of 1-10 with 1 being sober and 10 being drunk I would place [REDACTED] at between 8 and 9.

My dealings with [REDACTED] lasted no ore than 2 mins. I have made my judgement on the intoxication of [REDACTED] based on my experience as a police officer who has dealt with a large number of people who are in varying degrees of intoxication.

I am PC25252 David Jackson of Hampshire Constabulary stationed at Fratton Police Station, Portsmouth. On Saturday 17 April 2010 I was on duty in full uniform in Guildhall Walk where I was deployed as part of a High Visibility Patrol.

This statement concerns an incident of drunk and disorderly behaviour.

In this statement I will make reference to a male I arrested for drunk and disorderly behaviour who I now know as [REDACTED]. I will refer to him in this statement as [REDACTED]. Prior to this date, I have never seen [REDACTED] before and do not believe that I have ever had any prior dealings with him.

At approx 01:35 I was stood in Guildhall Walk close to the entrance to Roast Bar. I saw [REDACTED] in dispute with door staff and went to find out what the problem was. [REDACTED] walked towards me and kept pointing to a green stamp on his arm. He was saying that he should be readmitted to Roast Bar and that he wanted me to help him get back in.

[REDACTED] was slurring his words badly, he was very unsteady on his feet and was swaying around. I could smell intoxicating liquor on his breath and formed the opinion that [REDACTED] was drunk.

I clearly told [REDACTED] several times to go away from Roast as he would not be getting admitted and he therefore had no reason to remain in the area. [REDACTED] turned to walk towards the taxi rank but then ran back towards the door of Roast. I stopped [REDACTED] by running in front of him and blocking his path.

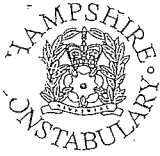
At this time [REDACTED] started to become more aggressive and abusive. He was shouting about getting back into the club. He turned and again walked towards the taxi rank. I followed him and saw he turn again to face me. [REDACTED] walked at pace towards me. He was now waving his arms around and was shouting.

As he came towards me I believed that [REDACTED] may intend to strike me so I blocked his path with the palm of my hand. I again repeated that he should leave. [REDACTED] brought his arms up again and pushed me backwards. I then took hold of [REDACTED] arm and told him that he was under arrest for being drunk and disorderly. [REDACTED] resisted and tried to pull away from me. I was joined by several colleagues and [REDACTED] was taken to the ground in a controlled way to allow control to be gained and prevent injury to Police or himself. [REDACTED] continued to resist and locked out his arms. He was kicking out wildly with his legs and nearly made contact with my legs on several occasions.

Once control was gained and [REDACTED] was handcuffed to the rear, I attempted to caution him. He was shouting abuse and I decided that he was incapable of hearing what I was trying to say. The arrest was necessary to prevent an offence against public decency.

The arrest was timed at 01:45. [REDACTED] was placed in a marked Police vehicle and taken to Portsmouth Central custody where his detention was authorised. I had no further dealings.
