





She was not very happy that the PCC Camera was not able to ID an offender leaving the venue as stated at the scene by agg'd. She also was not happy that the details that were provided to her were incorrect. She stated that someone said that had spikey blonde hair. I informed her that this was the description of the offender and she stated that another police officer had spoken to her and given her theses details. I asked who she called and she stated that it was 0845 so was probably police staff. I also spoke to her in relation to the ROAST BAR footage and have informed her that at thi stime i have not been able to view an assault or the agg'd or the offender. She was not very happy with this and i have stated that i need to speak to have in relation to the exact location of the assault. She stated that he is working away at this time and might not be available. I will try again this evening. She also stated that he was speaking to a PFC player. I do recall him saying this at the time and cant remember the players name but i do remember that the player in question was in South Africa as part of the world cup and i pointed this out to him at the scene.

She was particularly rude and aggressive and i found her to be very anti police. I had to challenge her comments on a number of occassions as i felt she was being very sterotypical towards police.

She also asked ref compensation and i informed her that in realtion to police this will not be possible unless an offender is detained in realtion to this matter. She again was not happy with this.

I also informed her that he signed my PNB and was abusive and obstructive towards me at the scene. She thinks that it is unacceptable to have had my PNB signed by him but this was his wish at the time. It is only after speaking to his mother that he wanted to make a complaint.

I offered PS JUSTER to speak to and at the time she stated that she didnt want to as he would only fob her off too. I explained that i have not fobbed her off and that she was not being fair to me.
