9. Project Integra

DECISION

On behalf of the Cabinet Member for Environment & Community Safety, Councillor Luke Stubbs agreed:

- 1. For the city council portfolio holder for Environment & Community Safety to remain a member of the Project Integra Strategic Board.**
- 2. For the Cabinet Member to accept the 2014-17 Action Plan (Appendix 2) but with the stated reservations and withdraw from any item for which it has not provided financial support. This would include the Recycle for Hampshire campaign, although it should be recognised that this does not lessen the council's commitment to recycling and positive resource management.**
- 3. That the annual subscription be funded from existing cash limits with the balance of £13,465 being funded from the carry-forward of underspend from the portfolio's 2013/14 revenue budget.**

10. Inspection plan for food business operators 2014 / 2015

Alan Cufley, Head of Corporate Assets, Business and Standards introduced the report.

Members acknowledged the hard work of the Environmental Health Business Support Team and were pleased with the progress made over the last 12 months.
