This report has been requested in response to concerns raised over queuing traffic entering the city centre in am peak periods following the installation of bus priority measures. The report considers the issues and evaluates a

proposal to enable all traffic to use the left hand lane of Mile End Road Approach between Havisham Road and Church Street.

**RECOMMENDATION**

**To retain all current bus lanes into the city centre for buses, taxis (hackney licensed) and pedal cycles only to support the delivery of the Portsmouth Plan and Local Transport Plan 3 outcomes.**
