### **Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions**

01. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-

(a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or

(b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his/her personal licence is suspended.

02. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

03. (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance or harm to children:

(a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage individuals to -

(i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or

(ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

- (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
  - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
  - (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on -
    - (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
    - (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
  - (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can be reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
04. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
05. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
06. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

07. The responsible person shall ensure that:

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold and supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures:-

(i) beer or cider: 1/2 pint;

(ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25ml or 35ml; and

(iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

(b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

### **Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule**

01. Staff shall monitor the activities of persons on the premises at busy times.
02. The licence holder shall ensure that a sufficient degree of illumination is provided to the exterior areas of the premises.
03. A 'drivers shelf' with a selection of soft drinks will be on display.
04. Zero tolerance towards illegal substances will be enforced at all times.
05. The CCTV system covering the premises shall be maintained in a satisfactory working condition and the recordings shall be kept for a minimum of 31 days.
06. The toilet facilities will be checked regularly.
07. The licence holder shall ensure that toughened drinking glasses are predominantly available for use by customers.
08. The licence holder shall ensure that regular noise surveys are undertaken whilst entertainment is taking place.
09. Customers are seen off the premises and encouraged to disperse at closing. Staff will arrange taxis for customers if needed.
10. Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.
11. Amplified live music shall be limited to a maximum of two entertainers and karaoke only.
12. An accident/incident book will be available at all times to staff and customers.

13. Annual service contracts will be maintained on equipment. Such certificates will be available for inspection by authorised officers in accordance with the Act.

14. No person under the age of 18 shall be permitted on the premises at any time.

15. The permitted hours for the provision of licensable activities as authorised by this licence are:

on New Year's Eve, except on a Sunday from 10:00 until 23:00 hours or on New Year's Eve on a Sunday from 12:00 until 22:30 hours and;

On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on the following day, which would be 10:00 hours if New Year's Day falls on a weekday or 12:00 hours on a Sunday.

16. The permitted hours restrictions do not prohibit:

- a) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
- b) consumption of the alcohol on the premises or the taking of sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;
- c) the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
- d) the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
- e) the sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces;
- f) the taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there; or
- g) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied; or
- h) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the

consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.

17. The permitted hours restrictions do not prohibit during the first thirty minutes after the cessation of the sale or supply of alcohol, the consumption of the alcohol on the premises.<sup>5</sup>

18. In accordance with paragraphs 6(8) and 18 (5) of Schedule 8 of the Licensing Act 2003, the licence holder shall have regard to the statutory provisions contained within the Children and Young Persons Act 1933 (as amended).

19. The licence holder has the discretion, subject to compliance with legislative provisions, to relocate the fire appliances, AWP machines, cigarette machines or any other similar objects temporarily in a fixed location which may impact on the ability of individuals on the premises to use exits or escape routes without impediment.
