- 1. Becketts are doubling the size of their premises and the licence would change the status from being just a wine bar/bistro.
- 2. This is a residential area and the increased business could cause a problem.
- 3. Noise from longer hours and live music was a big concern.
- 4. Parking problems --- having to use roads in the surrounding residential area, as their premises have no parking facility, with car doors slamming and loud talk in the early hours.
- 5. Tables and chairs at the front of the building, together with a smoking area, would encourage more customers to congregate there and create more noise.
- 6. Potential for anti-social behaviour due to long licensing hours.
- 7. Live music should finish at 11pm.
