These are some of the comments raised when signing the petition.

1. Becketts are doubling the size of their premises and the licence would change the status from being just a wine bar/bistro.
2. This is a residential area and the increased business could cause a problem.
3. Noise from longer hours and live music was a big concern.
4. Parking problems --- having to use roads in the surrounding residential area, as their premises have no parking facility,with car doors slamming and loud talk in the early hours.
5. Tables and chairs at the front of the building,together with a smoking area,would encourage more customers to congregate there and create more noise.
6. Potential for anti-social behaviour due to long licensing hours.
7. Live music should finish at 11pm.



OBJECTION TO APPLICATION BY BECKETTS, BELLEVUE TERRACE FOR PREMISES LICENCE

We, the undersigned, strongly object to the application for a premises licence by Becketts, Bellevue Terrace, for several reasons including noise from the music, noise from people sitting chatting at outside tables on the pavement into the early hours, possible anti-social behaviour due to the late opening hours (noise carries upwards and is very loud)...noise from cars leaving in the small hours... Elderly people live in very close proximity - across the road - and university students live in the adjacent hall of residence. This is a residential area and parking in this vicinity is very problematic.
