 - ... The attached is an interim report, midway through the financial year, to review

the city's housing market. Where relevant, comparison is made with regional and national markets. Like the last review in February 2009, this is not limited to home ownership but includes private (market) renting and social renting from the city council and housing associations, also known as registered social landlords or RSLs. Whether home purchase is becoming more affordable is not considered in this report; but will be reviewed in the next housing market update in early 2010 when income data from the Office of National Statistics – an essential element for defining degrees of affordability - will be available.

RECOMMENDED: that the Cabinet Member for Housing notes the current situation with the housing market in Portsmouth.

4. Supporting People Programme Update

... The purpose of the attached report is provide the Cabinet Member for Housing with an update on progress made on ongoing issues within the Supporting People (SP) programme in Portsmouth.
