## The Princess Royal Trust for Carers and Crossroads Care Survey of Primary Care Trusts



The National Carers Strategy announced £150m would be given to Primary Care Trusts (PCTs) over two financial years (2009-10, 2010-2011) to provide breaks for carers. Although this is new money, the £150m will be given to PCTs as part of their overall total allocation and they are not be advised how much of the £150m is contained within their total allocation. This means that there is no ring-fencing of the £150m and PCTs could choose to spend more or less on breaks for carers.

The amounts given are only estimates of how much of the £150m breaks for carers funding is contained within their total allocation. Our results are based on the information given to us by PCTs from Freedom of Information requests. There has been an element of interpretation but this has been done with a leaning towards generosity. We accept that some PCTs may feel that these results do not actually reflect all that they do but we are only able to base our findings on the information given to us.
