



AAA surgery: Crude mortality and country for intact aneurysms (n=25,773)




OUTCOMES = VOLUME

- Elective
 - High Volume = Best outcomes
- Emergency work
 - Concentrate facilities and personnel
- Cost Effective
 - Sustainable

THE PROPOSAL

- Single Team
 - consultant delivered
 - surgeon of week
- Enhanced presence in both sites
 - outpatients/rehabilatation
 - urgent referrals
 - intermediate surgery
 - other specialty support
- Major complex elective work one site
- Emergency intervention one site

ADAVANTAGES

- Improve outcomes
 - high volume elective
 - 7 day working
- Consolidate manpower/facilities for emergencies
 - No duplication
 - Critical mass of personnel
- Cost effective
 - consultant delivered
 - reduced admissions/ length stay
 - sustainable for future
 - No increase in man power
