#### So what do we do ......

Within mental health services we provide care and treatment for:

- Adults
- Older People
- Specialised Services care within a medium or low secure setting. We also provide specialist child and adolescent mental health inpatient care.



# Within learning disability services we provide care and treatment:

- ⇒ in partnership with Hampshire County Council Adult
   Services care for adults with learning disabilities
- Within in-patient settings services for those with psychiatric disorder, personality disorder or challenging behaviour
- Hospital liaison into acute hospitals



## TQtwentyone (our social care division)- provides a range of social care services to adults with learning disabilities and adults with mental health needs:

- Supported living
- Housing related support
- Specialist residential care
- Mental Health support
- Day Opportunities
- Support at home
- Short break services

### **Local (South East Services)**

- Older People's Mental Health Acute wards based at GWMH (Gosport War Memorial Hospital), community services based around the area
- Adult Mental Health Acute wards based at Melbury Lodge in Winchester (inc a mother & baby unit), Elmleigh in Havant (along with Hospital at Home) and a long term reablement unit at Hollybank (Havant). Community teams based in Fareham, Gosport, Havant and Petersfield
- ◆ Specialised Mental Health a medium secure unit based at Ravenswood, near Wickham
- ◆ A soon to be launched (January 2013) specialist Autistic Assessment service for Hampshire
- ◆ TQtwentyone head office based at the Potteries in Fareham, community services cover the whole area including Hayling Island and some on the Isle of Wight.
- ◆ LD (Learning Disability) services Main Assessment unit based at West End for specialised assessment for the area. Community services spread widely across the county.
- Community nursing teams again based widely across the county, Petersfield, Bordon, Chase, Fareham, Gosport (Community Hospitals based in those areas),
- Diabetes community nurses based at Fareham (working with Portsmouth Hospitals) an award winning service to support people living with diabetes
- Respiratory specialist nurses using 'Telehealth' to support people with conditions like COPD (Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease) in their homes
- Quit4Life Smoking cessation service covering Hampshire but not Portsmouth.
- Currently we provide from Havant a specialist mobile dental service (for people who can't leave home or for people with specialist needs)
