Advancing the use of technology in Adult Social Care (Telecare & Telehealth)

The Panel will continue receiving evidence for this review from the following witnesses:

 (i) <u>Katherine Barbour of The Wessex Health Innovation and Education</u> <u>Cluster (HIEC)</u> (The HIEC is a partnership of over 40 health and care organisation serving a population of around 3 million residents in Hampshire, the Isle of Wight, Somerset and South Wiltshire. The partnership

includes NHS trusts, local authorities, educational, voluntary and commercial organisations. The purpose is to promote innovation in healthcare services and healthcare improvement in tackling and preventing health problems.)

- (ii) <u>Graham Pink of Housing 21</u> (Brunel Court Manager) Housing 21 is a social enterprise and provider of affordable housing for older people. Brunel Court in Nutfield Place, Landport is a development of 55 extra care flats.
