4. Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 Appointment of Hackney Carriage Stand – King Henry 1st Street

Purpose

The matter has been referred to the committee for determination at the request of the ward councillor acting on behalf of the objector.

5. Department for Culture, Media and Sport – Legislative Reform Order: Proposal to exempt small live music events from the Licensing Act 2003.

Purpose
