4 Presentation by Head of Finance and s 151 Officer on the Budget 2013/14 (Al 4)

The Head of Finance and S151 officer, Mr Chris Ward, gave the presentation which it was also intended to be given to full Council at the budget meeting.

The presentation outlined the aims of the budget 2013/14, explained the financial background and explained the ongoing savings requirements. The S151 officer also explained that there would be a further budget meeting in Spring intended to address at least £2.4m (relating to Early Years provision).

In response to questions, the following points were clarified

- With regard to the reduction in the port income the downturn of the Euro has been a contributory factor.
- The estimated cost of a referendum on council tax would be around £39k
- 98.7% of council tax due is collected by PCC which is higher than average when compared with our statistical neighbours.
