4 Establishment of a Governance and Audit Committee

Purpose of Report

This report is to -

 Provide an update on the latest guidance from the Chartered Institute for Public Finance and Accountancy (CIPFA) regarding best practice to enhance governance arrangements and meet level 4 of the Comprehensive Performance Assessment (CPA) key line of enquiry on audit committees; and Make recommendations for the establishment of a governance and audit committee and revise the terms of reference of the Standards and General Purposes Committees.

Recommendations

- (1) That a Governance and Audit Committee, comprising 6 members (in political proportionality) together with standing deputies, be created as a regulatory committee with the functions and responsibilities set out in Appendix B;
- (2) That the chair of the Governance and Audit Committee be a member free of executive functions or responsibility for chairing a policy and review panel;
- (3) That the functions of the Standards Committee be revised -
 - (a) to exclude the following matters (which will now become the responsibility of the Governance and Audit Committee) -
 - Overview of complaints handling and Ombudsman investigations;
 - Overview of the City Council's "whistle blowing" policy;
 - Oversight of the Constitution;
 - Power to make or amend standing orders relating to contracts, and financial standing orders or regulations in relation to the conduct of council business;
 - Monitoring the question of the provisions relating to call in and urgency set out in Part 3 of the Constitution and submitting an annual report to the City Council if necessary.
 - (b) to include responsibility for member training and development.
- (4) That all the functions of the General Purposes Committee be re-allocated to the Governance and Audit, Development Control and Licensing Committees in accordance with the details set out in Appendix C.
- (5) That arrangements be made for members of the Governance and Audit Committee when appointed to receive appropriate training in their role and responsibilities.
