## (1) Exhibition on the experiences of Jewish children during the holocaust - information item

The City Council's Haifa-Portsmouth Friendship Link Committee is bringing an exhibition entitled "No Child's Play" to Portsmouth in January. The exhibition, which will be of interest to SACRE members, documents the circumstances in which Jewish children lived in Europe before World War 2 and how some of them survived the holocaust.
