The referral back to Cabinet by the Scrutiny Management Panel of the call-in Victory Energy Supply Limited - Expert Review of Business Case report by the Director of Finance was omitted from the Forward Plan for November 2018 (published 24th October covering that date until 18th January 2019). The purpose of the report (published 21 November) by the Director of Finance and Section 151 Officer will be for the Cabinet to re-consider the case for investing in Victory Energy Supply Limited (VESL) following the decision by the Scrutiny Management Panel on 21st September 2018.

The report will focus on all new information that is now available as well as providing clarification to the specific matters raised (i.e. grounds) within the "Call In" of the Victory Energy report considered by the Scrutiny Management Panel on 21st September 2018.

The report also responds to requests that have been made for additional information including a Social Impact Assessment and the financial impact of voluntarily adopting the Warm Homes Discount in advance of reaching the regulatory threshold (150,000 customers).
