4. Household waste recycling centre cross border charging and permit system change for vans and trade vehicles

### **The Cabinet Member**

- 1. Approved that Portsmouth residents will not need to register to use the Port Solent HWRC.
- 2. Noted that Portsmouth residents will need to register their vehicles to be able to use other Hampshire HWRC's without charge.
- 3. Delegated authority to the director of Housing, Neighbourhoods and Building services to develop a free permit scheme for Portsmouth residents wishing to use a van or trailer to use at the HWRC.
- 4. Noted that Portsmouth residents will need to register and pay for a permit if they want to access any of the other Hampshire HWRC sites using a van or a trailer.
