Purpose

The purpose of the report is to seek approval for the Coastal Partnership to extend the Partnership to include Chichester District Council as an additional partner.

Recommended that the Portfolio Holder:-

- (i) Approves the extension of the Coastal Partnership to include Chichester District Council as a member;
- (ii) Notes that the Head of the Coastal Partnership continues to discuss and explore with other local authorities in Hampshire and the Isle of Wight whether there is mutual benefit of extending the Coastal Partnership further should the opportunity arise; and
- (iii) Delegates authority to the Director of Regeneration, following consultation with the Executive Member for Planning Policy and City Development, to enter into a Section 113 Local Government Act Shared Service Agreement between Fareham Borough Council, Havant Borough Council, Portsmouth City Council, Gosport Borough Council and Chichester District Council.
