8 "Discovering Hampshire's Hidden D-Day Heritage " project with The Portsmouth D-Day Museum Trust. (information report) (Pages 151 - 154)

Purpose

Summarises the forthcoming "Hidden D-Day" project (working title) in association with The Portsmouth D-Day Museum Trust, funded by the National Lottery Heritage Fund (NLHF). Working with volunteers, the project will survey locations in the Hampshire countryside where troops camped before departing for Normandy, both before and after D-Day. It will also make available to a general audience, information about which troops were based at which camps and when.

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
