2	16/00737/FUL Fratton	<p>Store, Workshop & Garages Trafalgar Place Portsmouth</p> <p>Construction of two-and-a-half storey building to form six self-contained flats with associated cycle and refuse storage (after demolition of existing building)</p>	<p>Objections have been received from the occupiers of six neighbouring properties on the following grounds: loss of light from increased height of proposed building; exacerbation of existing parking and highway safety issues; proposed building too large and too close to adjoining properties resulting in loss of light and privacy and an increased sense of enclosure; impact of proposed building works on access/egress to and from adjacent properties; concern about displacement of rodents current living on site and potential for land contamination.</p> <p>It should be noted that a number of the objections refer erroneously to the redevelopment of a different site and raise points that are not relevant to the application site.</p> <p>This proposal follows two previous unsuccessful applications. During the determination period, amendments received have deleted a side projection that incorporated a seventh unit over an undercroft access. The proposal would remove a vacant and unsightly industrial building with the proposed residential units making a positive contribution to meeting the needs of the city.</p> <p>The scale of development proposed is considered acceptable and would not significantly harm the living conditions of the occupiers of neighbouring properties.
