The property also has an existing parking bay to the rear and therefore the application would increase the number of off-road parking spaces associated with the property to 3, which is more than required by the Adopted Parking Standards for a 4-bedroom property. Whilst the development would result in the loss of a space for on-street parking, it is considered that this is balanced by the additional provision of off-road parking for the property.
