		The electricity supply for events in the Guildhall Square is currently sourced through the use of generators. The cost of hiring and running these units compared to a permanent metered electrical connection being installed via the Civic Offices supply is significantly higher. A permanent solution also offers more flexibility and the opportunity to increase the number of events held in the Square increasing income generation.	City Development and Culture Tel: 9283 4165
