		Proposal: To carry out consultation with residents to seek support for implementing traffic calming within Elkstone Road.	Environment and Business Support Tel: 9284 1312
		The area is subject to a 20mph speed limit. Since its implementation various post scheme analysis has been carried out to ascertain the reduction of speed. Unfortunately, Elkstone Road has a high percentage of non-compliance of 58%. It has not seen the reduction in speed that was anticipated.	
		The proposed traffic calming scheme would seek to address the speed issues within the area by highlighting the existing 20mph speed limit and encouraging compliance using traffic calming methods.	
		The benefit of implementing three cushions for the full width of the carriageway within identified would be advantageous within Elkstone Road as their locations would not impact on the existing on-street parking facilities and there would be no loss of parking within the area. Elkstone Road is also an identified bus route within the area. The installation of speed cushions within the area would have little impact on buses utilising the route. Any emergency vehicles travelling through the area can travel more quickly over the speed cushions compared to that of full sized traffic humps or raised tables. The cushions can also be avoided by pedal cyclists utilising the area and the implementation of such traffic calming features would also see the existing surface water drainage system being unaffected.
