Appendix B- School Enforcement Cameras

School enforcement cameras were introduced in January 2017. There are currently two devices which are operated on a term by term rotational basis to cover twenty identified high priority sites. These sites have full infrastructure in place in preparation for the installation of these devices.

Initial sites-

- Solent Road
- Sundridge Close


Secondary sites-

- Gladys Avenue
- Stride Avenue

Enforcement is undertaken using an unattended camera system, which has been certificated for this purpose, which captures vehicles driving through the bus lane. A Civil Enforcement Officer then reviews the footage and if appropriate issues a PCN. PCNs are sent to the registered keeper of the vehicle usually within 14 days.

The PCN issued figures for each location are shown below-

School enforcement cameras appear a little more sporadic based on the information shown above, this is to do with the operational times of the cameras. They are only in operation Monday to Friday from 8am to 4pm as per the posted restriction. Additionally no enforcement is undertaken during holiday periods.
