- Improving English and maths skills for learners not yet at Level 2
- Accredited learning / qualifications
- Training Centre in Fratton with approx. 30 learners
- Progression to EET (including Apprenticeships)
 NB Study Programmes can also be accessed (on a cost recovery basis) by KS4 students at risk of disengaging / becoming NEET

Route to Work

- Corporate funded (HSBC) programme supporting young people in Portsmouth and Hampshire aged 16-24 to progress to EET
- RTW Employability Brokers provide one to one job search support and mentoring
- Provide a dedicated service that sources employment / apprenticeship opportunities and matches these to young people
- Financial support to assist with the cost of training may be available
