A proposal is made to re-designate the unused bus stop clearways within the 2 laybys, accommodating a stand for 3 taxis outside the store, and a feeder rank for 4 taxis opposite.  This requires an amendment to the traffic regulation order, associated legal processes and public consultation in accordance with traffic and Licensing legislation.  When the road layout was reconstructed to accommodate the new Tesco superstore, it incorporated 2 laybys as bus stop clearways for local public transport.  Ward councillors have highlighted a desire for taxi rank provision at the location, which the taxi trade has confirmed. As Fratton Way is no longer served by a bus route, re-designating the space for taxis is an appropriate use of the public highway.	To carry out a statutory public consultation on the proposals.  The TRO requires a period of 21 days consultation.  In addition, the appointment of the taxi rank under the 1976 Act requires a period of 28 days consultation (including consultation with the Chief Officer of Police).  It is anticipated that the consultation will take place from Wednesday 11th July 2018 as detailed opposite.  Whether or not the proposals are implemented will be influenced by the response to the consultation.
