The project aims to establish Portsmouth City Council as the lead commissioner for Continuing Health Care through Section 75 agreements, supported by the NHS Act 2006.

There are two key elements to the project; the first being an integrated assessment team of health and social care professionals providing assessments in a holistic manner to meet the needs of the local population. The second is integrated commissioning and contracting supported by a pooled health and social care fund.
