			Two letters of representation have been received in connection with this application.  A daily user of the shared garaging area comments that whilst he has no objection in principle to the proposal he is concerned to ensure that reasonable access to his own garage is maintained during the construction period. This is a private matter beyond the scope of planning control.  The occupiers of the adjoining property to the south have raised concern that a pitched roof (as opposed to the shallow monopitch roof as existing) will be out of character with, and significantly higher than, surrounding garages. Concern is also expressed about rainwater runoff (and the ability of the existing drain within the shared garaging area to cope) and the method of construction of the extension walls. Whilst the introduction of a pitched roof to the new outbuilding does not follow the	
			existing pattern of roof design within this garaging block, it is not considered to cause harm either to the character of the area nor to the amenities of surrounding occupiers. Drainage is a Building Control/private matter although details are provided on the submitted plans. The plans show the construction of cavity walls contained within the application site. Any party wall issues are beyond the scope of the planning application.  The application is considered acceptable in all other respects.
