A further objection from the owner of an adjoining property has been withdrawn following the submission of amended drawings. The application site is located within the secondary area of North End District Centre where policy PCS8 of the Portsmouth Plan supports the principle of residential uses. Having regard to the long term vacancy of this former office building it is considered that the change of use to residential is acceptable in principle. The site benefits from a car park at the rear that is shared with the adjacent former Cinema/Snooker Club. The applicant advises that they are legally entitled to use the allocated parking spaces between the hours of 8am and 6pm each day and to use the spaces outside of these hours if available. It is considered that having regard to the location of the site the proposed parking arrangements area acceptable and that the issue raised by the freehold owner of the site could not be a reason for the refusal of planning permission. It is considered that the proposed use would have an acceptable relationship with adjoining properties. Access to the site would remain from London Road and not Malthouse Road. An additional objection has been received on the grounds that the site plan submitted with the application does not accurately depict the actual layout and development of the site in reference to refuse and cycle storage and a footpath. It is considered that whilst the submitted drawings may not fully reflect the as built development, suitable facilities for the storage of cycles and refuse/recyclable materials can be secured this through the imposition of suitably worded planning condition. The principle of development, its design and relationship with neighbouring properties are considered acceptable. It is considered that the proposal would not result in a significant harmful impact on the local highway system or give rise to a significant increased demand for parking spaces. The marketing of the flats would not be a reason to refuse planning permission nor is the possible precedent that may be set in regard to the proposed development at the rear of the site. It is considered that as the bathroom and bedroom windows are located on the same elevation there would not be a loss of privacy. The developers have already made a Section 106 payment towards local infrastructure and further contributions would not be necessary or appropriate. 			The applicant seeks a planning permission that will enable the use of the property to interchange between a Class C3 dwelling house and a Class 4 HMO. The lawful use of the property is currently Class C3 (dwelling house). Having regard to the aims and objectives of policy PCS20 and the Houses in Multiple Occupation (HMOs) SPD that seek to support mixed and balanced communities, the use of the property as a HMO would not result in an imbalance of such uses, falling below the 10% threshold (2.27% if permission was granted).		
			It is generally considered that the level of activity associated with the use of any individual property as a Class C4 HMO is unlikely to be materially different to the use of a single household as a Class C3 dwelling house occupied by either a single family or other groups living as a single household. Therefore, it is considered that the proposal would not adversely affect the living conditions of the occupiers of the adjoining properties or put increased pressure on other Council departments. Other legislation beyond the planning system is available to address concerns relating to noise, disturbance and anti-social behaviour.
