		This application was reported on last week's MIS (1/3/13). Two additional representations, one further comment from a previous objector and one clarifying the extent of a previous objection have been received. A total of six objections have now been received from local residents on the following grounds: development out of character with area; inappropriate relationship with adjacent properties; increased noise and disturbance; inadequate parking and exacerbation of existing parking problems; inadequate drainage infrastructure; and impact of construction works. The application site comprises an irregularly shaped parcel of land with a narrow frontage to Havant Road and a much larger frontage to Basin Street at the rear. A workshop for the repair of vehicles occupies the entire site, which has a two-storey scale/massing to the rear. The proposal would involve the redevelopment of the site for residential		
			purposes with an infill terraced house being built fronting Havant Road and a two-storey building comprising two flats to the rear fronting Basin Street. Having regard to the nature of the existing industrial use and the scale of the existing building it is considered that the proposal would reduce the potential for noise and disturbance to neighbours and not have any greater impact on amenity. It is considered that the proposal is appropriate in design terms and would not appear at odds with the character of the area. Whilst the proposed redevelopment would not include any parking, regard must be had to the level of demand for parking associated with the existing use and that an additional on-street space could be provided in Havant Road following the removal of the existing dropped kerb. Having regard also to the location of the site within 100 metres of the Kingston Road Local Centre and proximity to a high frequency bus corridor it is considered a refusal on parking grounds could not be justified. It is accepted that building works can lead to temporary issues with noise and disturbance; however this in itself could not be a reason to withhold planning permission.
