This Portsmouth City Council application relates to the use of a small unit at Bastion 4 on Scott Road as a gym. The application indicates that three parking spaces would be allocated within the adjoining gravel car parking area in addition to shared facilities along the length of Scott Road. It is considered that there is sufficient capacity within the surrounding area for the parking of vehicles associated with all of the units within the Bastion. The allocation of individual spaces and the management of the car park to avoid any conflict would be a matter for the City Council as landlord of the bastion and adjoining car park.
