Email of support from The Portsmouth Society for retention of iconic tower (of former Odeon cinema). The proposal relates to a shopfront, ATM and external alterations. The Highways Engineer raises no highways objection but comments on the relationship of the proposed ATM to the bus lane, taxi rank and double yellow lines as well as cars temporarily stopping traffic by turning right into and out of Derby Road junction. Illegally parked vehicles by owners stopping to use the ATM may contribute to congestion, have an impact on bus journey times and could increase the likelihood of accidents. Whilst an ATM in this location may encourage illegal parking on the highway such occurrences would, however, be enforced by traffic management measures and are unlikely to result in a significant impact on the use of the carriageway or would be likely to prejudice highway safety overall. The works will be funded through the estimated £350k pa savings to the Supporting People Programme budget as a result of the remodelling of support services, and so there will be no additional cost to the Authority.	
		The future Mill House site service will hold four independent support services for different levels and type of need, and will mean a reduction in service users from 47 to approximately 32.	
		The Mill House Hostel is 2/3rds owned by PCC and leased to Two Saints Housing Association on a long term lease agreement.
