Their objection relates to the new door proposed on the Oxford Road frontage which they considered to be inappropriate given the residential character of the road. Permission is sought for the installation of new shop fronts to the Albert Road and Oxford Road frontages, amending a similar application approved in November 2012 (ref.11/00980/FUL). Just like the previous application, the proposals include a new door to the Oxford Road frontage in addition to the main entrance on Albert Road. The applicant has again indicated that this door would be used for emergency purposes only and would not include an external handle. The only differences in this application to that previously approved relate to the external materials used in the fabrication of the shopfront, slight variations to the main entrance on Albert Road and changes to the window design. Having regard to the scheme previously approved, it is considered that the proposed shopfront is of an acceptable design and the inclusion of an additional access/egress point onto Oxford Road would not be sufficiently harmful to the residential amenity of occupants in Oxford Road to warrant a reason for refusal, or a condition restricting its use.
