This application seeks a planning permission that will enable the use of the property to interchange between a Class C3 dwellinghouse and a Class 4 HMO should the applicant wish to let the property to a family/related group of individuals for a period of time. The lawful use of the property is currently Class C3 (dwellinghouse). Having regard to the aims and objectives of policy PCS20 and the draft Houses in Multiple Occupation (HMOs) SPD, the use of the property as a HMO would not result in an imbalance of uses within the community, falling below the 10% threshold, and is not considered to adversely affect the living conditions of the occupiers of the adjoining or nearby properties.
