The aim of the policy is to report upon the:

- Local Air Quality Management (LAQM) process and the 2018 Review and Assessment (R&A) of air
  quality (AQ) in Portsmouth through the publication of the 2019 Annual Status Report (ASR)
- Legal responsibilities placed upon Portsmouth City Council (PCC) in respect to AQ by the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (DEFRA)
- Actions undertaken and proposed by PCC which are likely to positively impact upon air pollution levels in Portsmouth.

Benefits: Improving air quality by reducing air pollution has positive health impacts for all. It is recognised that poor air quality is a contributing factor in the onset of heart disease and cancer.
