To The Licensing Manager,

I would like to strongly object to the proposed variations of license for Fratton ASDA, Bridge Centre. to enable 24 hour shopping and the increased sale of alcohol.

As a long standing Resident of Garnier St which "back's on to ASDA's I am very concerned for the potential again for,

- 1) Anti-Social Behaviour
- 2) Noise Pollution in the Early-Hours
- 3) PARKING Issues. (Not all ASDA shoppers use ASDA CarPark) and Park in Garnier street & other Roads close-by.

I feel very strongly that there should not be a 24hr Opening Super-Market within a Residential Built up Area.

Garnier street had a long-history of ASB. Some years ago due to "Late-Sales of Alcohol"

And Garner Street Formed a Residents Association of which I was the chair-person.

As a Association we opposed another shop's application for a 24hr license to "Sell-Alcohol" & were successful in stopping this application with support from P.C.C. Community Safety Team & the Police.

I feel that if ASDAS Application was successful that it would open the Flood-Gates for other shops to apply again for a 24hr License.

I Therefore strongly oppose this application on the above grounds & think again the shop is putting "Profit before People" & hope that these objections are taken seriously. In the past ASDA have been very fair in maintaining the Gate after "closing", which was put in place approx 9 year ago & reduced the A.S.B within Garner St & the Crime figures for the area.
