Based on the developments electrical demand being supplied by grid electricity the projects combined utilities carbon footprint will be 9.66 tonnes CO2 per year. Further information is contained within the Carbon Footprint Report for LCT project (June'18). Reducing carbon emissions is a requirement of the main funder of the LCT project - ie the National Lottery Heritage Fund. We will be encouraging people to travel to see LCT on foot, by bicycle and using public transport.

Negative environmental impacts have been reduced through the specification of low energy consuming display and external lighting. The lighting is designed with smart control gear which will allow complete flexibility in the operation of the lighting systems. This will ensure that lighting is not left on during out of hours. In addition to energy performance the external lighting is designed in compliance with the ILP guidance document governing sky glow effect which will minimise disturbance to wildlife. All fittings will be LED with low maintenance requirements and long life. All available opportunities have been identified to minimise the negative environmental impacts through the specification of small power and electrical equipment.

The development lies within Flood Risk Zone 3 as indicated on the Environment Agency flood map. On this basis the site is considered to be at a low risk of flooding. The flood mitigation considerations indicate that no increase in flood risk, either on site or downstream, has been introduced as a result of the development and no flood risk reduction measures are required. The new access to the D Day car park will be formed through a bellmouth arrangement and located approximately 105m west of the existing access. The segregation of the access points for vehicles and pedestrians will result in a betterment in the

existing conditions and reduce the likelihood for conflict at this point given that pedestrians and vehicles currently share a single point of access through an informal shared surface arrangement. Further information is contained within the LCT project Transport Statement (May'18).
