Those who receive accreditation are awarded with the Living Wage Employer mark. In order to gain and maintain accreditation, all Local Maintained (LA) schools must adopt the FLW rate. The accreditation also covers procurement practice stating that contractors and their subcontractors providing a service on the council's behalf should pay their employees the Living Wage and also meet any annual increases in the Living Wage Rate, but only where employees work for more than 2 or more hours a week or 8 or more weeks in the year.

The implementation of Living Wage will impact more females than males due to the fact that the postholders of the roles affected are predominantly women. Therefore, implementation of the Living Wage will promote equality for women.

How are you going to measure/check the impact of your proposal?

This will be measured against the FLW Accreditation toolkit for the measures that the Council need to take in order to achieve the accreditation.

FLW accreditation does not require that all contracts are uplifted changed straightaway, this can be done over time as and when the contracts come up for renewal or natural break points in the contract. However, it is expected that the Council can demonstrate a planned timeline of when these changes will be made.
