I am giving this certificate because I am of the opinion that other procedures under the Licensing Act are inappropriate in this case, because⁴:

Following a number of incidents at the premises over the weekend of 30th and 31st July 2021 it is clear that the operation of the premises has fallen short of the required standard in order to fully support the licensing objectives at the premises.

The risk of further incidents causing harm to women using the premises and becoming the victim of further sexual assaults is unacceptable. The risk of further incidents of violence is also unacceptable.

Other powers available to the Police to manage this risk have been considered. However the use of a review under S53A of the Licensing Act 2003 is believed to be the most appropriate in the circumstances.

It is the view of the Chief Officer of Police that immediate action is required to prevent further serious incidents of crime and disorder, harm to the Public and to implement a comprehensive review of the current operating practices used at the premises. I have
