Following a proposal with full Cosham ward member support, the sum of $£ 116,835.39$ from the Cosham ward neighbourhood CIL total is proposed to be allocated as a contribution towards the provision of a new public multi-storey car park to provide additional patient and visitor parking on the Queen Alexandra Hospital site.

The Contribution will enable (amongst other supportive measures) improved signage across the site, barrier-less entry using Number Plate Recognition, remote payment options, infrastructure to support electrical vehicle charging, improved access to the north entrance of the hospital site and pedestrian crossing points.

The project will be delivered by appointed contractors.

Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) - Neighbourhood spend to fund a contribution towards the provision of an inclusive roundabout located within Kingston Recreation Ground.

Following a proposal with full Fratton ward member support, the sum of $£ 4,057$ from the Fratton ward neighbourhood CIL total is proposed to be allocated as a contribution towards the provision of an inclusive roundabout that will be located within Kingston Recreation Ground.

The inclusive roundabout will provide an important form of play equipment that can be accessed and enjoyed by all. It will complement the existing provision within Kingston Recreation Ground and provide a valuable form of physical and mental stimulation that will encourage and promote community cohesion.
