		On 13 <sup>th</sup> February 2014 the Cabinet Member for Education approved the allocation of £38,750 to replace one slate roof at Wimborne Infant School. With the schools contribution to the scheme there is an existing budget of £45,000 for this scheme. On inspection it was found the adjacent roof is in the same condition and a cost of £80,000 will allow both roofs to be recovered. Due to the increase in the cost an additional contribution of £6,273 will be sought from the school. This therefore leaves a shortfall of £28,763.	
		At the same time £163,274 (total budget of £200,000 including school contribution) was approved for roof repairs at Charles Dickens Primary School. On receipt of the tendered quotes the estimated cost of these repairs is now £121,000.	
		Approval is therefore sought to re-allocate £28,763 from the Charles Dickens Primary scheme to fund additional roof repairs at Wimborne Infant School.

Representations have been received from the occupiers of five neighbouring residential and commercial properties raising objections and concerns about the potential for noise and disturbance if rear garden area were to be used by patrons of the Class A3/A4 use and suggesting that conditions 13 and 14 of the previous permission should be re-imposed to protect the residential amenities of the occupiers of neighbouring properties at the rear. One of the objections raises the issue of noise and disturbance from construction work affecting occupiers of a neighbouring commercial property.  The restrictive conditions attached to the previous permission relating to the use of the garden area would be re-imposed to protect the residential amenities of the occupiers of neighbouring properties at the rear. Building works inevitably result in some localised and temporary noise and disturbance, however this would not be a justifiable reason to withhold permission.
