The sub-committee felt that it was appropriate that conditions should be added to the licence to promote the licensing objectives. The premises licence holder had agreed to the conditions set out on exhibit 5 of the licence, which was circulated at the meeting, save for the questions of CCTV and SIA door staff. Accordingly the licence was amended to the following for the sale of alcohol, performance of live music and playing of recorded music: • Sunday - Thursday 12 noon until 2300 hours • Friday and Saturday 1100 hours until 2359 hours.	
		The conditions 2=>12 are imposed on the licence as are conditions 16 through to 19, plus an agreed condition that no alcohol is to be taken outside of the front of the premises at any time. In terms of the proposed conditions, 13, 14 and 15 which relate to the SIA door staff, the subcommittee had heard no evidence which convinced them that it is appropriate and proportionate to impose such conditions. However, the sub-committee was satisfied that CCTV is an integral requirement in these premises to promote the licensing objectives. As such, CCTV is to be installed as set out in the proposed conditions and the sub-committee considered that it was appropriate and proportionate to suspend the licence until this condition is completed.
