The strategy includes commitment to protecting biodiversity, increasing tree coverage, increasing wildflower habitat and restricting pesticide use to a minimum. In addition to the response to Q B3, the strategy references our natural open spaces Baffins Pond, Milton Common, Hilsea Lines and Portsdown Hill and the steps taken at these sites to increase biodiversity and protect wildlife.
