In order to install the bus lane, it would be necessary to remove existing "Pay & Display" parking places on the south side of Lake Road between Alexandra Road and Cornmill Roundabout. It is also proposed to introduce a "no waiting at any time" restriction on Foster Road from its northern closed end southwards for 10 metres. This is to facilitate access for cycles from the new cycle path adjacent to Lake Road onto the cycle route on Foster Road. The proposed restriction would also enable vehicles to turn around at the closed end of Foster Road, rather than having to reverse to the junction with Hale Street North. Plans showing the proposed restrictions are available from the case officer.	To progress a TRO to introduce a Bus Lane on Lake Road westbound between Holbrook Road and Cornmill Road, and associated waiting restrictions (in place of approximately 16 "Pay & Display" parking spaces outside Catisfield House, Blendworth House and Rogate House, and approximately two "Pay & Display" spaces outside the Salvation Army church and community centre) on Lake Road, and at the northern end of Foster Road.
