and how?	The main focus of the revised policy is to support increased permanence for children in their family network, complying with legislation, statutory practice and case law.

The revised policy is a fairer reflection of the Special Guardianship Regulations 2005 and the DfES guidance to the regulations. These guidance and regulations govern the processes by which local authorities exercise their discretion in determining requests for special guardianship support services, including Regulation 6 financial support. The finance policy has been developed to set the parameters to ensure all special guardianship carer applications for financial assistance are treated fairly and lawfully. The revised policy will pay financial support after assessment until a child is 18 or there is a change of circumstances.
If you are directly or indirectly discriminating, how are you going to mitigate the negative impact?	Some special guardian carers financial payments have been stopped since 2017 and it may be that they require a further financial assessment to determine a need to backdate payments and for payments to continue in line with the policy. To date 45 carers have been identified where this may apply, and we will be writing to them to undergo a new financial assessment to determine whether they are eligible for any further financial support.
