Thank you for providing a copy of your noise management plan. From its content it would appear that the mitigation of the noise relies heavily on the sound insulation between the commercial and residential properties. Unfortunately, until you have provided the local authority with details of the materials that you will be using and provide a report to show that the performance standard of the airborne sound insulation $D_{nT,w+}$ Ctr is greater than 55dB, then unfortunately Regulatory Services are unable to support you variation application for the change of operational hours.

The report should also demonstrate that the premise can contain the volume both inside(87dB) and outside (34dB) the venue. It is recommended that you appoint an acoustic consultant to assist you with this matter.
