## Appendix 1 - Coastal Site Risk Assessments

#### Zone 2b - Pyramids to Coffee Cup (page 17 & 18)

- Adjustment to history of incidents section from 'unknown' to reflect that the RNLI lifeguard kiosks record all incidents within working hours for the months of July and August
- Adjustment to significant hazards section to include jumping from the pier and to reference the strong tidal currents around the Southsea Castle rock revetment that have been known to catch out paddleboarders
- Adjustment to description of zone east of pier to include reference to the inshore leisure vessel passage through the submerged barrier opposite Canoe Lake which can introduce moving vessels as a risk to people in the water
- Addition of Lifeguarding to Management section to reflect presence of contracted lifeguard service in July and August

#### Zone 3 - Coffee Cup to Eastney (page 23)

- Adjustment to history of incidents section from 'unknown' to reflect that the RNLI lifeguard kiosks record all incidents within working hours for the months of July and August
- Addition of Lifeguarding to Management section to reflect presence of contracted lifeguard service in July and August

 Addition of wording referencing potential for submerged hazardous objects due to being former landfill site
