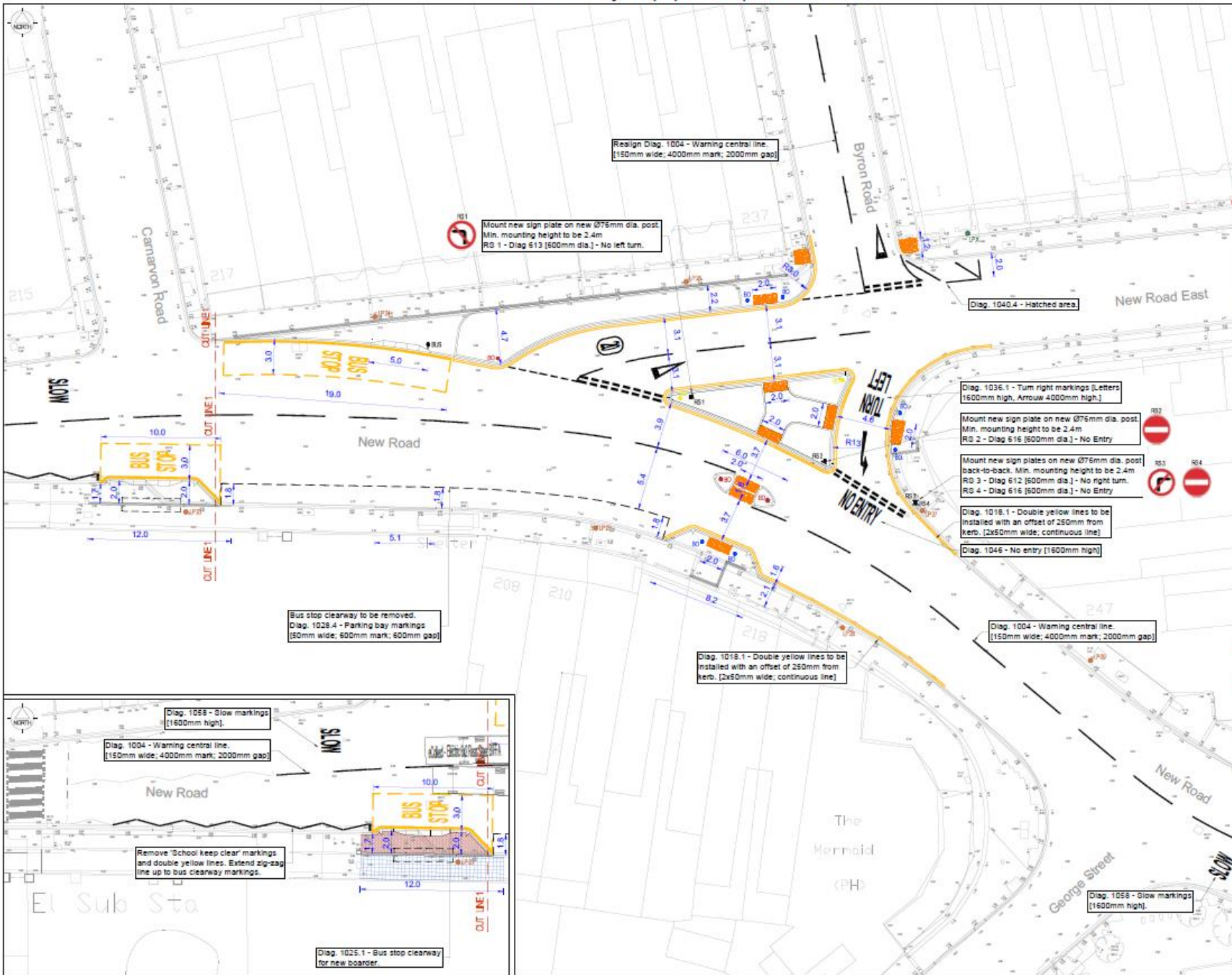

### **Portfolio: Transport**

1	<b>Fratton</b>	<p>The Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) team is currently seeking consent to advertise waiting restrictions on New Road and New Road East. This proposal is part of a Safer Routes to School scheme; it was identified that the road layout at the junction of New Road and New Road East would benefit from being reconfigured to improve road safety and encourage active and sustainable travel to the nearby Penbridge Junior School.</p> <p>The improvements included in this scheme would be to re-profile the junction between New Road and New Road East, by building out the kerbs, and constructing a new traffic island. It is anticipated that these improvements would reduce speeds and make it easier for pedestrians to cross at this junction, as shown on the accompanying plan</p> <p>To support this scheme a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) has been proposed to introduce "No Waiting at Any Time" restrictions (double yellow lines) around the junction and in visibility splays on both New Road and New Road East. It is also proposed to ban right turns from the easternmost junction onto New Road from New Road East and ban left turns from the westernmost junction.</p> <p>As part of these works the bus stops would be relocated and the controlled area of the Zebra crossing (i.e. the zigzag markings) reduced. A plan showing the proposals is shown below.</p> <p>If you have any comments or concerns about this proposal, please contact the case officer, quoting reference P034-24 . If the TRO team does not hear from you within 7 calendar days of the date of this MIS paper (i.e. by 16 August 2024), they will commence the public consultation process. 		<p>advertising the changes in the press, on the PCC website, notices posted on street furniture, and letter drops to properties directly affected by the proposals.</p> <p>All representations received in response to the formal consultation will be assessed, and all objections reported to the Cabinet Member for Transport at a Transport Decision-meeting; the Cabinet Member can either decide that the Order is made (wholly or in part), or not made. Alternatively, he can defer the decision to a later meeting. However, it should be noted that if a permanent TRO is not made by two years after publication of the Notice of Intent, it expires, and the process would have to re-start as a new TRO.</p>	
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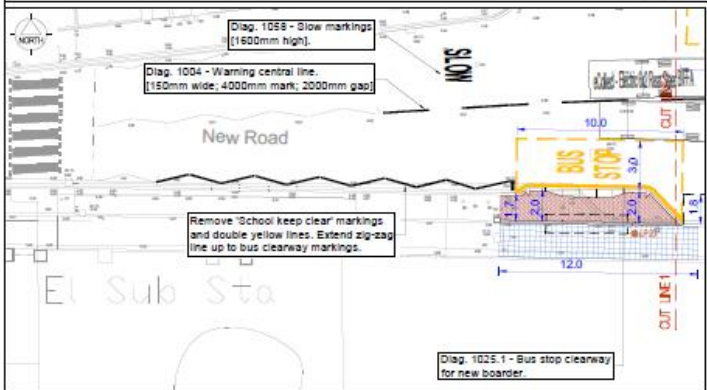
